TRANSPORTATION TO CAMP (PLEASE KEEP THIS SHEET FOR YOUR RECORDS)

ARRIVAL

Flying: Please schedule flights to **arrive** in Toronto between **10:00 am and 2:00 pm EST** in order to ensure a timely arrival at camp. This allows campers time to unpack and settle in all together.

Campers arriving at Toronto Airport will be met personally at the gate by a senior staff member from either Camp Ak-O-Mak or Camp Chikopi, our brother camp.

All international campers, including those from the USA must first:

1. Claim luggage at the "Baggage Claim".
2. Follow the signs to Customs with your valid passport.
3. Exit customs with your luggage to be met by a camp staff member. Passports, plane tickets, etc. will be collected the first day of camp for safe keeping.

Please review this protocol with your daughter.

Driving: Please plan to arrive at Ak-O-Mak anytime after 2:00 pm. It is important for safety reasons that your daughter register at the Main House before moving into her cabin.

DEPARTURE

Flying: Please book flights **departing** from Toronto Airport between the hours of **11:00 am and 2:00 pm, EST**. Campers **CANNOT** get to the airport in time for flights any earlier than 11:00 am. Remember, passengers are asked to be at the airport 2-3 hours pre-flight and we have a 3 hour drive to the airport!

Driving: Campers will be packed and ready for pick up anytime before noon. Please "sign out" at the Main House.
