Camp Ak-O-Mak has a camp uniform worn by the campers each day.

Mandatory Camp Uniform:

- Four navy blue lightweight shorts (no denim) If you are unable to find navy you may substitute black
- Ten white tee shirts (Some writing is acceptable on the shirt—No inappropriate writing)
- Two pair of athletic/spandex shorts
- NO FLIP FLOPS PLEASE (Sandals with toe protection are required)

Suggested Packing List:

- 4 Navy blue shorts (may substitute black)
- 2 pair of athletic/spandex shorts (required)
- 10 White tee shirts
- 1 White shorts
- 2 Pair of sweat pants (any colour)
- 1 Lightweight Jacket
- 1 Raincoat/Poncho
- 2 or 3 Swimsuits—at least 1 one piece
- 2 Swim caps
- 2 Pair of swim goggles
- 10 Pair of socks

- 10 Pair of underwear
- 2 Long sleeve shirts (any colour)
- 1 Heavier Jacket/Fleece
- 2 Pair of Pajamas
- 3 Pairs of supportive running shoes
- Hat(s) for sun protection
- Sunglasses
- 1 Pair of sandals (must strap on feet)
- 3 Beach towels
- 1 Pair of Bike gloves (Mandatory)
- 1 Pair of Cycling shorts

Bedding:

- 1 Set of sheets (twin size)
- 2 Blankets
- 1 Pillow
- 1 Pillow case
- 1 Sleeping bag

Optional:

- Tennis racquet, Softball glove, Musical Instrument
- Bike, Bike Helmet, Wet Suit,
- Competitive swimmer should bring their swim bag

Toiletries/Sundries & Personal Effects:

- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Hairbrush
- Feminine products if needed
- Biodegradable Soap & Shampoo (only please)
- Laundry Bag
- Sunscreen & Insect repellant
- Flashlight & batteries
- Water bottle
- Pen, paper, envelopes for letters home

Required:

Campers are required to wear the camp uniform each day—white tee shirt and navy shorts are mandatory White shorts are needed for Sundays. Campers should have enough camp uniform clothing to last seven days as laundry will be done on a weekly basis. All clothing should be machine washable, Campers should have a laundry bag.

No Denim clothing.

Do Not Buy New If Something Old Will Do.

Plastic storage containers or trunks that fit under the bunks are required for storage of clothing as they permit easier folding of clothes and can be sealed to keeps animals out. The storage containers should be no higher than 22 inches or 55 cm.
